Offered Semester	Spring Semester
Topic	Learning Japanese composition writing and Kanji.
Class Outline	Students will review the spelling, definition and how to write kanji from the <i>Intermediate Japanese</i> textbook and kanji review tests will be conducted to check student's acquisition situation to develop their kanji skills. The students will also establish basic rules of writing compositions and practice writing short essays in class. The students will be able to write an understandable short essays by looking over the corrections of grammar and expression made by the teachers. This process will also help students to improve their kanji skills.
Objectives	Students are required to set a goal to achieve high scores for every kanji review tests. From the test results, students will recognize their mistake and weakness. This will help to review and master the correct kanji. Composition writing will help students to develop skills to think logically and write their opinions. The aim of composition writing is to master Japanese language skills such as grammar, vocabulary, and expressions by learning from the corrections made by teachers or from short essay examples. This process will also help students improve a wide range of kanji skills.
