(Course guide for foreigners already residing in Japan.)

SUMMARY

- *We are accepting students who already obtain an appropriate visa. (except student visa)
- *You will study 4 skills (speaking, listening, reading, writing).
- *This course is mainly planed for those who intend to study in Japanese universities, graduate schools, or vocational schools and want to get a job in Japan.
- *The course period of the autumn course is 18 months.
- *For your graduation of the autumn course, your test score, attendance rate and submitting report will be required.
- *Regarding to capacity of acceptable applicant, it may be less, in case many applicants with college student visa are permitted for entrance.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

1. completed 12 years of standard school education

Academic ability is regarded as the equivalent of 12 years standard education.

(If the term of study is shorter than 12 years because of the public education system, please inquire at the office before applying.)

2. completed studying at a Japanese Language School in your home country for more than 150 hours or completed the Japanese Proficiency Test grade N5 or almost same level.

- 2 Statement of Reason for Admission
 - If it is written in language other than Japanese, please prepare Japanese translation.
- ③ Copies of your passport (The copies of the page with your photo and your information, and of the page with the stamp about your residence status.)
- 4 The copy of a resident Card. (both side)
- ⑤ 3 pieces of photograph(3 x 4 cm)
- ⑥ Official graduation certificate, or the copy of the original diploma from the last educational institution.
- 7 Certificate on your learning Japanese
 - Japanese Proficiency Test
 - J-Test
 - A certificate showing that the applicant has studied at Japanese Language school.

(ex: studying term or hours).
