The science of shopping

Many people don't think about shopping as a science, but some scientists like to study shopping. One area that they study is the time it takes for customers to make decisions about what to **purchase**.

Supermarket purchasing decisions

In a recent study in Australia, researchers **investigated** how long people take to decide when they are purchasing different products. They discovered that the easiest decision that people make is about milk. People take an average of 14.7 seconds to decide on which milk to purchase. Deciding on toilet paper is also not difficult, because people only take 21.2 seconds. Bread can be more of a challenge for people though, and it takes 29 seconds to decide. Choosing the right cheese is even more difficult, taking an average of 34.8 seconds. People care about their pets a lot too, so it takes an average of 43.5 seconds to decide on dog food and 49.5 seconds for cat food. This was only **slightly** faster than decisions on baby care products, which took 50 seconds. Finally, the items that take the most time are beauty products, with skin care items taking 52.9 seconds, and hair care items taking 56.2 seconds.

For more expensive items, it's not surprising that people take a long time to make decisions. According to one recent **survey**, the average car buyer spends a total of 14 hours and 48 minutes when purchasing a car. Over 60% of this time is spent on the internet, reading **reviews** of the cars that they are interested in. It is very important for people to know if the car they are planning to buy will be **reliable**. Of course, buying a house usually takes even more time. One study in the United Kingdom suggests that the average time it takes from starting to look for a house to buying it is about 16 weeks. However, the moment a buyer finds the right house, the **actual** decision can be very quick. An average of 17 minutes is all it takes. **Persuasion** from the **real estate agent** is one of the big **factors** that influences their decisions.

31. Daichi



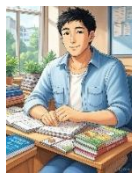
Daichi is a university student who likes music. He often works as an MC at school events. He is good at making people happy. He likes working with music and people in a lively place.

Sometimes tourists ask about Okinawan food culture too, so staff need to connect international and local culture. This booth is always lively and attracts many people who want to try something new.

4. Music & Drink Booth

This booth sells drinks like juice and iced tea. It is near the stage. Staff need to serve drinks quickly and be active. This booth is often crowded with people who like music.

5. Bakery Booth

This booth sells fresh bread and cakes. Staff need to prepare the bread and keep the booth clean. The work needs careful hands and tidy work. They will prepare food more than talk to people. It is a good place for quiet and hardworking people.
